AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 32, SECTION 20,
THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, 1957.
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF
ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That Section 20, Chapter 32, of The Code of The
City of Abilene, Texas, 1957, be, and it is hereby, amended so
as to hereafter read as follows:

"Sec. 32-20. SAME; NIGHT-TIME FISHING UNLAWFUL, *water skiers prohibited*
"It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to fish
in Lake Kirby in the night-time, and by night-time is
meant from sunset of one day until sunrise of the fol-
lowing day, *and no person shall engage in water skiing at either*
Lake Abilene or Lake Kirby."

Section 2: Any violation of this section shall be a mis-
demeanor and upon conviction thereof in the Corporation Court
of The City of Abilene, shall punished by a fine not to exceed
TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00).

PASSED ON FIRST READING this the 25th day of September, 1958.

at two separate meetings of the Board of Commissioners; said
