ORDINANCE NO. 856

Chief of Police

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON OR PERSONS TO BRING OR CARRY INTO OR HAVE IN HIS POSSESSION AN INTOXICATING BEVERAGE WITHIN ONE OF THE PARKS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE; PROVIDING FOR THE SEIZURE THEREOF; PROVIDING A PENALTY AND ~~SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING.~~ DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,
TEXAS:

Section 1: That Chapter 18 of the Code of the City of Abilene, Texas, 1957, be, and it is hereby, amended by adding Section 53, which shall read as follows:

"Sec. 18-53(a). It shall hereafter be unlawful for any person or persons to bring or carry or have in his possession within any public park in the City of Abilene any intoxicating beverage.

(b). Provided that if any officer of the City of Abilene or of the State of Texas sees any person or persons violating the terms of sub-paragraph (a) of this section, he shall immediately seize such intoxicating beverage and shall within a reasonable time thereafter deliver same unto the City Attorney, who shall hold same as evidence until the trial of the accused party, and shall thereafter dispose of same.

(c) Any person or persons violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon the conviction thereof shall be fined any sum not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) and not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)."

PASSED ON FIRST READING this the 12th day of June, 1958.
