ORDINANCE NO. 935

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 32-10 (B), OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, 1957, REQUIRING ALL PERSONS OPERATING OR RIDING IN BOATS TO WEAR AN APPROVED LIFE PRESERVING DEVICE; REQUIRING ALL WATER SKIERS TO WEAR ETC., AND REQUIRING ALL BOATS TO CARRY AT LEAST ONE PADDLE IN GOOD CONDITION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That Section 32-10 (B), of the Code of the City of Abilene, TEXAS, 1957, be, and it is hereby, amended so as to hereafter read as follows:

(B) Any person operating or riding in any boat shall wear at all times an approved life preserving device sufficient to sustain such person. No person shall water ski without wearing an approved life preserving device sufficient to sustain such person. All boats must carry at least one paddle in good condition.

PASSED AND APPROVED ON FIRST READING THIS 21st day of May, A.D. 1959.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS hereby finds that an emergency exists requiring suspension of the rules provided in Section 32 of the City Charter requiring an ordinance be read and passed at two separate meetings of the Board of Commissioners and said rule is hereby suspended and said ordinance is passed twice at one and the same meeting of the Board of Commissioners.
