ORDINANCE NO. 958

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF ABILENE ALL THAT PROPERTY BEING A PORTION OF LAND BEING THE CONTINUATION OF HARTFORD STREET: GRANTING THE RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF CITIZENS OF THE CITY TO THOSE RESIDING IN SAID TERRITORY: AND CALLING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE 31ST DAY OF AUGUST, 1959, AT 8:30 A.M.

WHEREAS, the following described property is land or territory lying adjacent to the present city limits of the City of Abilene; and,

WHEREAS, it appears expedient and necessary to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, that said property be annexed for all purposes in accordance with the City Charter, and request has been made therefor, ~~by the owners of all property therein contained.~~

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

SECTION I: That in accordance with Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, Texas, as amended, the following described property is hereby annexed to and included in the corporate limits of the City of Abilene, said territory being adjacent to the present city limit lines and being described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the present City Limits, said point being at the intersection of a line 500 feet west of the West right-of-way line of U. S. Highway 83 By-pass and the North right-of-way line of Hartford Street;

THENCE in a westerly direction along the North right-of-way line of Hartford Street to the South East Corner of a 15.85 acre Abilene School tract,

THENCE N $0^{\circ} 36'$ E 538 feet to a beginning of a curve to the left;

THENCE along the said corner to the left with a central angle of $89^{\circ} 47'$, radius of 250.9 feet and tangent 250 feet, a distance of 393.2 feet to the end of said curve,

THENCE S $89^{\circ} 38'$ W 909.8 feet to the north west corner of the said school tract,

THENCE South 520.2 feet to a point in the South right-of-way line of Hartford Street,

THENCE in an easterly direction along said right-of-way to a point 500 West of the West right-of-way of U. S. Highway 83 By-pass;

THENCE north 80 feet to the place of beginning.

SECTION II: That upon final passage hereof, said property as annexed shall be part of the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, and of Abilene Independent School District, and the property situated herein shall bear its pro-rata portion of the taxes levied by the City and the School District, and the inhabitants thereof shall be entitled to all the rights and privileges of all the citizens and shall be bound by the Acts, Ordinances, Rules, and Regulations of the City.

SECTION III: Said property shall be zone as follows: Temporary Zone "A" to Zone A-25.

SECTION IV: That a public hearing be held at 8:30 o'clock A.M. on the 31st day of August, 1959, in the chambers of the Board of Commissioners at the City Hall in Abilene, Texas, at which time all interested persons shall be given full opportunity to be heard in opposition or support of said annexation.

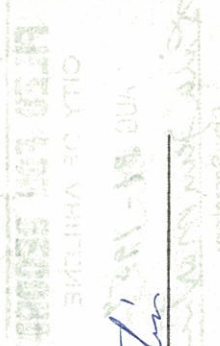
PASSED ON FIRST READING This the 30th day of July, 1959.
