ORDINANCE NO. 981 4152

AN ORDINANCE NAMING
A STREET EAST AMBLER
AVENUE, AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

SECTION I: That a portion of AMBLER AVENUE, a street lying and situated in the City of Abilene, Texas be, and it is hereby designated and named EAST AMBLER AVENUE, said portion beginning at CEDAR CREEK and extending eastward. Said numbering system to begin east of said CEDAR CREEK and increase to the East.

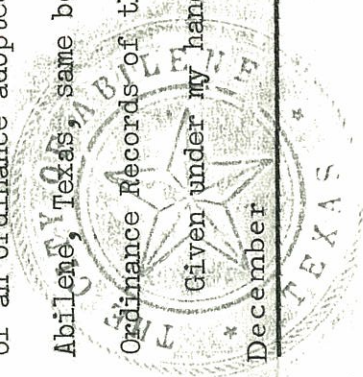
