

*Ord # 1027*

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING

L. A. GRIMES,

INTERIM CITY MANAGER

WHEREAS, on the 25th day of June, 1960, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene adopted a motion to the effect that L. A. Grimes be appointed to serve as City Manager of the City of Abilene, on a temporary basis; and that he be so designated effective July 1, 1960; and,

WHEREAS, said, L. A. Grimes did agree to such appointment, and did report for work in behalf of the City on June 27, 1960, and is now serving as City Manager under such appointment; and,

WHEREAS, it is agreeable to both said L. A. Grimes and the City that said Grimes continue to serve the City as City Manager on a temporary basis, and said Board of Commissioners and L. A. Grimes have agreed upon the conditions and terms upon which the said Grimes is to serve:

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene;

(1) That the appointment of L. A. Grimes as City Manager for the City of Abilene, effective July 1, 1960, to serve on a temporary basis, in such capacity, subject to discharge by said Board as soon as a permanent City Manager can be appointed and qualified, is hereby confirmed.


(2) That the said L. A. Grimes shall be paid a consultant fee of one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars per month effective June 27, 1960, for services rendered as City Manager for such period of time as he shall serve in said capacity; and further that said Grimes shall devote all the time necessary during such appointment to discharge fully the duties of City Manager.

(3) That said Grimes shall indicate the exceptance of the terms and conditions of this Ordinance in his behalf by signing his name at the foot hereof.

Be it further ordained, that to meet the emergencies which exist on the account of the resignation of Henry Nabors as City Manager effective June 30, 1960, and the necessity that exist for the position of City Manager to be filled, the rule that every ordinance shall be introduced in writing in the form which it is intended to be finally passed, read and published before final passage, as set forth in the Charter of the City of Abilene, Article IV, Section 32, be and the same is hereby suspended by a unanimous vote of the Board of Commissioners, and that this Ordinance be read twice and declared finally passed and adopted at one meeting this date.
