

Ordinance # 1046

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS MAKING CHANGES IN THE NAMES OF CERTAIN STREETS AS SET OUT AND DESCRIBED BELOW; SAID STREET CHANGES IN THE CITY OF ABILENE AS WERE REQUESTED BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT AND THE POST OFFICE DEPARTMENT. AND RECOMMENDED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE

CITY OF ABILENE:

SECTION I The following street names are hereby changed:

1. Present Arizona Avenue changed to Ruidosa Avenue - said street being located from Steffens Street to Laguna Drive.
2. Present California Avenue changed to Corsicana Avenue - said street being located from the alley of Lamesa Avenue to the alley south of Pueblo Drive and from Waldemar Street to Hartford Street and from Andy Street to Texas Drive.
3. Present Colorado Drive changed to Presidio Drive - said street being located from Aztec Drive to the alley south of Pueblo Drive and from Waldemar Street to Hartford Street.
4. Present McGee Drive changed to Hill Street.
5. Present Hill Street changed to McGee Drive.

SECTION II The following new streets are hereby named:

1. Bataan Street a North and South Street located the Third Street East of T & P Lane from Hailey Street to Minda
2. Manila Street a North and South Street located the Fourth Street East of T & P Lane from Hailey Street to Minda
3. Sunrise Avenue a North and South Street located the Second Street East of T & P Lane from Hailey Street to Minda
4. Castle Drive a North and South Street located about 1200 feet East of T & P Lane from Formosa Street to Midway Street

After said passage a notice of time and place, where and when said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the 12th day of November, 1960, the same being more than one (1) week prior to the time designated for said hearing. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said ordinance was passed on second and final hearing.
