ORDINANCE NO. 1059

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF PENROSE STREET TO GRIFFITH STREET BEING LOCATED FROM THE INTERSECTION OF STAMFORD AND STATE HIGHWAY 351 TO E. N. 10TH STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION I: That the name of Penrose Street, said street being located from the intersection of Stamford and State Highway 351 to E.N. 10th Street, be and it is hereby changed to Griffith Street.

PASSED ON FIRST READING ON THIS THE 15<sup>TH</sup> day of December, A.D., 1960.

After said passage a notice of time and place, where and when said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December, A.D., 1960, the same being more than one (1) week prior to the time designated for said hearing. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said ordinance was passed on second and final hearing.
