

ORDINANCE NO. 1061

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ABILENE; NAMING A STREET WHICH IS ABOUT TWO OR THREE HUNDRED FEET NORTH OF LOWDEN STREET WHICH RUNS FROM PINE STREET TO CEDAR STREET SAID STREET TO BE NAMED FORESTER STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION I: That a street being located about two or three hundred feet North of Lowden Street which runs from Pine Street to Cedar Street, be, and it is hereby named Forester Street.

PASSED ON FIRST READING ON THIS THE 15th day of December, A.D., 1960.

After said passage a notice of time and place, where and when said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the 20th day of December, A.D., 1960, the same being more than one (1) week prior to the time designated for said hearing. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said ordinance was passed on second and final hearing.

PASSED ON SECOND AND FINAL READING on the 29th day of December, A.D., 1960.

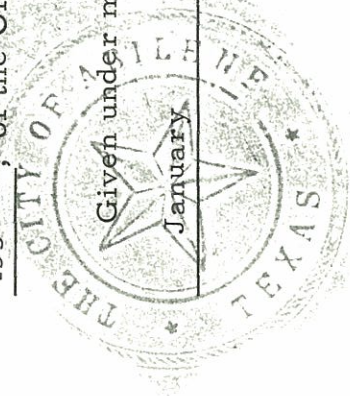
