

## ORDINANCE NO. 986

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF ABILENE A CERTAIN AREA LYING EAST OF THE CITY OF ABILENE AND KNOWN AS EAST ABILENE AND IN TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR THE ZONING OF THE SAME AND GRANTING THE RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY TO THOSE RESIDING IN SAID TERRITORY; PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE 7<sup>th</sup> day of JANUARY, A.D., 1960.

WHEREAS, the following described property is land or territory lying adjacent to the present city limits of the City of Abilene; and,

WHEREAS, it appears expedient and necessary to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, that said property be annexed for all purposes in accordance with the City Charter.

AND WHEREAS, the following described property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION I: That in accordance with Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, Texas, as amended, the following described property is hereby annexed to and included in the corporate limits of the City of Abilene, said territory being adjacent to the present city limit lines and being described as follows:

BEING all that certain land in Taylor County, Texas, described as follows:

BEGINNING at the NW corner of the City of Abilene Municipal Airport property, as same existed in December, 1956, at a point in the South right-of-way line of old State Highway No. 36, from which point the NE corner of Section 52, Blind Asylum Lands bears S. 89 deg. 31' E. 1366 feet and North 50 feet;

THENCE with the West boundary line of said airport property;  
S. 0 deg. 21' W. 2208.9 feet;  
N. 89 deg. 39' E. 500 feet  
S. 52 deg. 30' E. 422 feet;  
S. 43 deg. W. 1668 feet;  
S. 37 deg. 30' E. 792.2 feet;  
N. 52 deg. 30' E 2312.2 feet;  
S. 52 deg. 30' E 741.7 feet;  
S. 0 deg. 21' E. to a point in the South boundary line of Section 53, Blind Asylum Lands;  
THENCE W. with the South boundary line of said Section 53 and 52 to a point in the East R.O.W.

line of Farm Road Number 1750, from whence the S.W. corner of said Section 36 bears West 10 feet;

THENCE in a northerly and northwesterly direction with the East boundary line of said Farm Road Number 1750 to its intersection with the North property line of Berry Land (extended);

THENCE west with the existing boundary line of Berry Lane to its intersection with the East boundary line of Lakeside Drive;

THENCE North with the East boundary line of Lakeside Drive to its intersection with the South R.O.W. line of the present State Highway Number 36;

THENCE with the South R.O.W. line of the present State Highway Number 36 in an easterly direction to its intersection with the East line of Castle Drive;

THENCE with the South R.O.W. line of old State Highway Number 36 in an easterly and southeasterly, and an easterly direction to the place of beginning.

SECTION II: That upon final passage hereof, said property as annexed, shall be part of the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, and the property situated herein shall bear its pro-rata portion of the taxes levied by the City, and the inhabitants thereof shall be entitled to all the rights and privileges of all the citizens and shall be bound by the Acts, Ordinances, Rules, and Regulations of the City.

SECTION III: Said property shall be zoned as ~~Zone "A"~~ Zone "A".

SECTION IV: That a public hearing be held at 1:30 o'clock P.M. on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of JANUARY, 1960, in the chambers of the Board of Commissioners at the City Hall in Abilene, Texas, at which time all interested persons shall be given full opportunity to be heard in opposition or support of said annexation.

PASSED ON FIRST READING THIS the 25<sup>th</sup> day of November A.D., 1959.

AFTER said passage, said ordinance was published in final form in the Abilene Reporter-News, daily newspaper published in the City of Abilene, on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of November, A.D., 1959, which date was more than thirty (30) days prior to the date of the public hearing and the date that the same was finally acted upon by the Board of Commissioners.

PASSED ON SECOND AND FINAL READING THIS the 7<sup>th</sup> day of January, A.D., 1960.
