

ORDINANCE NO. 994

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF NINDANAO STREET TO NINDA STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the name of Nindanno Street, said street being located North of East Horizon Subdivision, be, and it is hereby changed to Ninda Street.

PASSED ON FIRST READING ON THIS THE 4th day of February, 1960.

After said passage a notice of time and place, where and when said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the 9th day of February, A.D., 1960, the same being more than one (1) week prior to the time designated for said hearing. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said ordinance was passed on second and final hearing.
