

ORDINANCE NO. 1119

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 26-5 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, 1957, AS AMENDED, BY INCREASING THE FEE FOR HOUSE MOVING PERMITS TO TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to instructions from the City Manager, the City

Building Official conducted a survey of fees charged for house moving permits in other cities comparable in size to Abilene; and,

WHEREAS, as a result of this survey it is determined that said fees in the City of Abilene should be increased, and it is the desire of the Board of Commissioners that same be increased; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That Section 26-5 of The Code of The City of Abilene, Texas, 1957, as amended, be, and the same is hereby, amended so as to hereafter read as follows:

"Sec. 26-5. FEES.

"No moving permit shall be issued unless the Applicant therefor shall pay a fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) to the Building Inspection Department."
