

ORDINANCE NO. 1125

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THAT PART OF CHAPTER 25 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, 1957, AS AMENDED, PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF BICYCLE LICENSE FEES, ENTITLED "SEC. 25-9. LICENSE FEES"; RENUMBERING CERTAIN SECTIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, Texas, has determined the payment of bicycle license fees to be a burden and unnecessary prerequisite to use and enjoyment of bicycles in the City of Abilene; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That Section 25-9 of The Code of The City of Abilene, Texas, 1957, as amended, entitled "LICENSE FEES" be, and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: That Section 25-10, "BICYCLE LIGHTS", and Section 25-11, "PENALTY", of The Code of The City of Abilene, Texas, 1957, as amended, be and the same are hereby renumbered Section 25-9 and Section 25-10, respectively.

PASSED ON FIRST READING this 21st day of September, A. D. 1961.
