

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 59 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, 1957, "TRAFFIC CODE", BY MAKING THAT PART OF NORTH 11TH STREET BETWEEN GRAPE AND PARK STREETS A THROUGH STREET PROTECTED BY STOP SIGNS; BY MAKING NORTH 10TH STREET A ONE-WAY STREET EAST FROM PARK TO GRAPE STREET; BY MAKING NORTH 11TH STREET A ONE-WAY STREET WEST FROM GRAPE TO PARK AVENUE; BY MAKING PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON BOTH SIDES OF NORTH 10TH STREET BETWEEN MOCKINGBIRD AND KIRKWOOD; PROVIDING A PENALTY; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, the Traffic Engineer of the City of Abilene has established several traffic regulations on an experimental basis as required by ordinance and said regulations have proved a desirable aid to traffic safety within the City of Abilene and the Traffic Engineer has recommended that such regulations be made permanent; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That Chapter 59 of The Code of The City of Abilene, Texas, 1957, commonly known as the Traffic Code, be, and the same is hereby, amended as follows:

(a) That Schedule 4, One-Way Streets, be amended by adding thereto the following:

- 20. North 10th - One-way from Park to Grape Street - East
- 21. North 11th - One-way from Grape to Park Street - West

(b) That Schedule 5, Thorough Streets Protected by Stop Signs, be amended by adding thereto the following:

58. North 11th from Grape to Park Street

(c) That Schedule 8, Parking Prohibited at all Times, be amended by adding thereto the following:

34. North 10th - Both Sides - Between Mockingbird and Kirkwood.

Section 2: That any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be subject to a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).

Section 3: That should any portion of this ordinance be held to be invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall in no way affect the remaining portion of this ordinance or the remaining sections of The Code of The City of Abilene, Texas, 1957.

PASSED on first reading this 13th day of April, A. D. 1962.

After said passage a notice of time and place, where and when said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of April, 1962, the same being more than one (1) week prior to the time designated for said hearing. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said ordinance was passed on its second and final reading.

PASSED on second and final reading this 27th day of April, 1962.
