

ISSUANCE OF PERMITS BY TELEPHONE, AND CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, it would be to the convenience of both the City of Abilene and local electricians to allow the limited issuance of electrical permits by telephone; and,

WHEREAS, the Electrical Inspector is at present prohibited from taking such action; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That Section 27-13 of Chapter 27 of The Code of The City of Abilene, Texas, 1957, as amended, be, and the same is hereby, amended to hereafter read

as follows:

"Sec. 27-13. INSPECTION FEES.

"A. The following inspection fees shall be paid by the applicant to the City Building Inspection Office upon application for a permit:

"(1) Service (move, change or alter)	\$ 1.00
"(2) 5 electric openings or less	1.00
"(3) Electric openings in excess of five	.10 each
"(4) 5 electric fixtures or less	1.00
"(5) Electric fixtures in excess of five	.10 each
"(6) Electric range	1.00
"(7) Electric water heater	1.00
"(8) Electric garbage disposal	.50
"(9) Dishwasher	.50
"(10) Unit Heater	.50
"(11) Washing machine	.50
"(12) Door bells or chimes	.25
"(13) Exhaust or ventilating fans	.25
"(14) Electric welders	1.00
"(15) Gasoline pump	1.00
"(16) Elevators, dumbwaiters, escalators	3.50 each
"(17) Motors, 1 hp or less than 3 hp	.75
"(18) Motors, 3 hp and less than 5 hp	2.00
"(19) Motors, 5 hp and over	3.00
"(20) Incandescent signs	1.50
"(21) Neon signs	1.50
"(22) Re-inspections	2.00
"(23) Motion picture machines	2.00
"(24) Generators: inspection fee for electrical generators including switchboard and incitors of ten kilowatts or less capacity shall be	3.00 each

"Except, there shall be a minimum charge of Two Dollars (\$2.00) per trip for such inspections.

"Notice: Permit holders whose installations are ready for inspection shall allow the office of the Electrical Inspector twenty-four (24) hours, Sundays and holidays excluded, before proceeding with the installation.

shall be made with the Electrical Inspector by the applicant.

"(2) An account shall be kept for each applicant by the Electrical Inspector in an accounts receivable book, which book shall be subject to the approval of the Accounting and Auditing Department.

"(3) No part of the aforesaid deposit shall be applied to the account of any applicant.

"(4) Applicants shall be billed once each month for the total balance of his account and the official written permit shall be enclosed therein.

"(5) All accounts shall be payable within ten days after the billing date; any account not paid within the said ten days shall not be eligible for further issuance of permits pursuant to the aforesaid provisions, and the applicant's deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Abilene.

"(6) Permits exceeding Five Dollars (\$5.00) shall not be issued under the foregoing provisions. "

PASSED ON FIRST READING this *18th* day of October, A. D. 1962.

After said passage, a notice of the time and place, when and where said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the *2nd* day of *October*, 1962, the same being more than one (1) week prior to the time designated for said hearing. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said ordinance was passed on second and final hearing.
