

ORDINANCE NO. 129

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE BOUNDARY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, AND THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY CONSISTING OF APPROXIMATELY 10.71 ACRES OF LAND, TO-WIT: BEGINNING AT A POINT IN THE NORTH BOUNDARY LINE OF SECTION 62 OF BLIND ASYLUM LANDS, SAID POINT BEING 230 FEET WEST OF THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SAID SECTION 62, AND SAID POINT ALSO BEING IN THE EXISTING CORPORATE LIMIT LINE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, THENCE SOUTH 0 DEGREES 28 MINUTES EAST FOR A DISTANCE OF 210 FEET TO A POINT, THENCE NORTH 89 DEGREES 59 MINUTES EAST PARALLEL TO THE NORTH BOUNDARY LINE OF SECTION 61, BLIND ASYLUM LANDS, FOR A DISTANCE OF 2222 FEET TO A POINT, THENCE NORTH 0 DEGREES 28 MINUTES WEST FOR A DISTANCE OF 210 FEET TO THE NORTH BOUNDARY LINE OF SECTION 61, BLIND ASYLUM LANDS, SAID BOUNDARY LINE COINCIDING WITH THE CORPORATE LIMIT LINE OF ABILENE, TEXAS; THENCE SOUTH 89 DEGREES 59 MINUTES WEST ALONG THE NORTH BOUNDARY LINE OF SECTION 61, BLIND ASYLUM LANDS, 2222 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, WHICH TERRITORY LIES ADJACENT TO AND ADJOINS THE PRESENT BOUNDARY LIMIT OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS; AND CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, a public hearing before the City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas, where all interested persons were provided with an opportunity to be heard on the proposed annexation of the hereinafter described property, was held at 8:30 A.M. on the 13th day of August, 1964, which date is not more than twenty nor less than ten days prior to the institution of annexation proceedings; and,

WHEREAS, notice of such public hearing was published in a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Abilene, Texas, and in the hereinafter described territory on the 27th day of July, 1964, which date is not more than twenty nor less than ten days prior to the date of such public hearing; and,

WHEREAS, the total corporate area of the City of Abilene, Texas, on the first day of January, A.D. 1964, was 42,630 acres; and,

WHEREAS, the population of the City of Abilene, Texas is 101,649 inhabitants; and,

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described territory lies within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Abilene, Texas; and,

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described territory contains 10.71 acres; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the following described land and territory lying adjacent to and adjoining the City of Abilene, Texas, is hereby added and annexed to the City of

Abilene, Texas, and said territory hereinafter described shall hereafter be included within the boundary limits of the City of Abilene, and the present boundary limits of such city, at the various points contiguous to the area hereinafter described, are altered and amended so as to include said area within the corporate limits of the City of Abilene, Texas, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the North boundary line of Section 62 of Blind Asylum Lands, said point being 230 feet West of the northeast corner of Section 62, Blind Asylum Lands, and said point also being in the existing corporate limit line of the City of Abilene;  
THENCE South 0 deg 28 min East for a distance of 210 feet to a point;  
THENCE North 89 deg 59 min East parallel to the North boundary line of Section 61, Blind Asylum Lands, for a distance of 2222 feet to a point;  
THENCE North 0 deg 28 min West for a distance of 210 feet to the North boundary line of Section 61, Blind Asylum Lands, said boundary line coinciding with the corporate limit line of Abilene, Texas;  
THENCE South 89 deg 59 min West along the North boundary line of Section 61, Blind Asylum Lands, 2222 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2: That the above described territory and the area so annexed shall be a part of the City of Abilene, Texas, and the property so added hereby shall bear its pro rata part of the taxes levied by the City of Abilene, and the inhabitants thereof shall be entitled to all of the rights and privileges of all the citizens and shall be bound by the acts, ordinances, resolutions and regulations of the City of Abilene, Texas.

Section 3: That this ordinance shall be published and passed in the manner provided in Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, Texas, and the City Secretary shall give notice that a public hearing shall be held thereon at 8:30 A. M., September 24, 1964, in the Council Room of the City Hall, Abilene, Taylor County, Texas.
