

Section 1: That Section 28-97 of The Code of The City of Abilene, Texas, 1957, as amended, be, and the same is hereby amended so as to hereafter read as follows:

"Sec. 28-97: No water closet shall discharge into a stack less than three inches (3") in diameter. "

Section 2: That Section 28-105 of The Code of The City of Abilene, Texas, 1957, as amended, be, and the same is hereby further amended so as to hereafter read as follows:

"Sec. 28-105: Vents, Sizes Required. The required sizes of main vents or vent stack shall be determined on the basis of the number of fixture units to be vented in accordance with the following table:

161 to 500
501 to 1000
1001 to 1500
1501 to 2400

6" 50
8" 120
10" 180
12" 300

"Water closets may be installed on 3" house drains as outlined in paragraphs (c) and (d) of this section."

Section ~~4~~⁵ If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the provision or application of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section ~~5~~⁶ That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00). Each such violation which shall continue or be permitted to continue shall be deemed a separate offense and shall be punishable as such.
