AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, REPEALING ORDINANCE #444, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE USE OF THE MUNICIPAL AUDITORIUM AND PRESCRIBING RATES FOR USE OF SAME", PASSED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ON OCTOBER 26, 1951; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE #793, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7-8 OF THE ABILENE CITY CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY", PASSED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ON APRIL 18, 1957, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that the 1951 Rules and Regulations for the use of the Municipal Auditorium, and a 1957 amendment thereto should be repealed; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:

Section 1: That Ordinance #444, entitled "An Ordinance Prescribing Rules and Regulations for the use of the Municipal Auditorium and Prescribing Rates for use of Same", passed by the Board of Commissioners on October 26, 1951, be and the same is hereby in all things repealed.

Section 2: That Ordinance #793, entitled "An Ordinance amending Section 7-8 of the Abilene City Code and Declaring an Emergency", passed by the Board of Commissioners on April 18, 1957, be and the same is hereby in all things repealed.

Section 3: That the City Council hereby finds that an emergency exists requiring suspension of the rule provided in Section 18 of the City Charter requiring ordinances to be read on two separate days, in that the immediate passage of said ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare, and said rule is hereby suspended and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force and effect from and after its passage.
