ORDINANCE NO. 237

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING OFFICIAL NAMES FOR FORMER COUNTY ROADS NOW WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE; AUTHORIZING THE TRAFFIC ENGINEER TO ERECT STREET NAME SIGNS; AND PROVIDING FOR PASSAGE.

WHEREAS, the City Planning and Zoning Commission has heretofore held a public hearing on a request to give an official street designation to two county roads now within the corporate limits of the City of Abilene; and,

WHEREAS, such Commission has recommended names to be given such county roads, and the City Council of the City of Abilene is of the opinion that such names should be made permanent; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That a road adjacent to the North boundary of Dyess Air Force Base be and is hereby designated Military Drive, from Spur 312 to Tye City Limits.
Section 2: That a county road running East and West past Wylie School be and is hereby designated Antilley Drive.

Section 3: The Traffic Engineer of the City of Abilene is hereby authorized to erect signs designating such permanent street names, in appropriate places.
