

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, NAMING THE DYESS AIR FORCE BASE ENTRANCE ROAD, FROM THE DYESS AIR FORCE BASE MAIN ENTRANCE GATE TO HIGHWAY 80 WEST, ARNOLD BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, a certain street in the west part of the City of Abilene, running from the Dyess Air Force Base main entrance gate to Highway 80 west, is presently not designated by a name; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the City Planning and Zoning Commission that the street be named Arnold Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that such street should be so named; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the street from the Dyess Air Force Base main entrance gate to Highway 80 west be, and is hereby, named Arnold Boulevard.

Section 2: That the City Engineer be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to change his maps, plats and records to indicate such name.

Section 3: That the City Planning Department be, and is hereby, authorized and directed to change its maps, plats and records to reflect such name, and further that the City Planning Department shall provide notice of the naming of such street to any other City department, including the Fire and Police Departments, affected by such change.
