ORDINANCE NO. 449

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AMENDING SECTION 3-10 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, BY INCREASING LANDING FEES FOR SCHEDULED COMMERCIAL AIR CARRIERS TO TEN CENTS (\$.10) PER THOUSAND (1,000) POUNDS GROSS WEIGHT.

WHEREAS, the Administrative Staff of the City of Abilene has recommended that the Landing Fees at the Abilene Municipal Airport be increased from eight cents (\$.08) to ten cents (\$.10) per thousand (1,000) pounds gross weight; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council of the City of Abilene that the landing fees at the Abilene Municipal Airport be increased to ten cents (\$.10) per thousand (1,000) pounds gross weight in accordance with the recommendation of the Administrative Staff of the City of Abilene; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:

PART 1: That Section 3-10 of The Code of the City of Abilene, Texas, be, and the same is hereby, amended as follows:

"Section 3-10. Scheduled Commercial Air Carriers - Generally.

Every person operating a scheduled commercial air carrier in and out of the Municipal Airport of the City shall pay a landing fee for the use of the runway, taxiway and parking apron at the airport of ten cents per one thousand pounds (or fraction thereof) of known gross weight of the aircraft, according to the manufacturer's data. Such charge shall be made for each scheduled trip arrival." Provided that the landing fees will not be increased within three years.


PART 2: This Ordinance shall become effective the 1st day of October,


