Municipal ORDINANCE NO. 534

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 15 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE AS AMENDED BY FURTHER AMENDING SECTION 15-16 BY DELETING THE WORDS "ONE DOLLAR" AND SUBSTITUTING THE WORDS "TWO DOLLARS" THEREFOR, PROVIDING A PENALTY AND PROVIDING FOR PASSAGE.

WHEREAS, the Abilene-Taylor County Board of Health has recommended that Chapter 15 of the City Code which is titled "Health & Sanitation" be amended to delete the words "one dollar" from Section 15-16 and the words "two dollars" be substituted therefor.

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that such recommendation of the Abilene-Taylor County Board of Health should be followed; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That Section 15-16 of Chapter 15 of the Code of the City of Abilene, Texas, be, and the same is hereby amended by deleting the last two words of the paragraph "one dollar" and substituting therefore the words "two dollars".

SECTION 2: That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Chapter shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$200.00 and each such violation which shall continue or be permitted to continue shall be deemed a separate offense.

PASSED AND APPROVED on first reading this the 27th day of May, A. D., 1971.

After said passage a notice of time and place, where and when said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter News, the official newspaper of the City of Abilene, said publication being on the 24th day of June, A. D., 1971, the same being more than 24 hours prior to the time designated for said hearing. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said ordinance was passed on second and final reading.

PASSED AND APPROVED on its second and final reading this the 24 day of June, A. D., 1971.
