

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 29 OF THE ABILENE CITY CODE BY REPEALING THE EXISTING SUB-SECTION (e) OF SECTION 29-23 THEREOF AND ENACTING A NEW SUB-SECTION (e) OF SECTION 29-23; PROVIDING THAT THE RATE OF FARE FOR TRANSPORTATION OF PASSENGERS BETWEEN THE CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT AND THE ABILENE MUNICIPAL AIRPORT; TAXICABS AND OTHER VEHICLES FOR HIRE SHALL CHARGE A FLAT RATE OF TWO DOLLARS (\$2.00) PER ADULT PERSON TRANSPORTED; CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: Chapter 29 of the Abilene City Code is hereby amended by repealing the existing Sub-Section (e) of Section 29-23 thereof and enacting in lieu of said Sub-Section (e) the following:

(e) for transportation between the central business district and the Abilene Municipal Airport, taxicabs and other vehicles for hire shall charge a flat rate of Two Dollars (\$2.00) per adult person transported. For the purpose of this sub-section, any person over the age of twelve (12) years shall be deemed an adult.

SECTION 2: Upon passage of this Ordinance on first reading, the City Secretary shall be, and she is hereby authorized and directed to have published in the Abilene Reporter News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, a notice that a public hearing will be held in the Council Chambers of the City Hall in Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, at 9:00 A. M. on the 9th day of March, A. D. 1972, to permit the public to be heard prior to consideration of this Ordinance for a second and final reading, said publication to be at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the time of such public hearing.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall become effective the 10th day of March, A. D. 1972.
