

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, CHANGING THE NAME OF A ROAD THAT HAS BEEN PLATTED PARTIALLY AS RESTWAY ROAD AND PARTIALLY AS AMY LYN AVENUE TO AMY LYN AVENUE.

WHEREAS, a certain street in the City of Abilene has been partially platted as Restway Road and partially as Amy Lyn Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the City's Planning and Zoning

Commission that the entire street should be named Amy Lyn Avenue to avoid confusion of the public and residents of the area; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that such street should be named Amy Lyn Avenue; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the street now platted partially as Restway Road and partially platted as Amy Lyn Avenue is hereby changed, and the name of said street will hereafter be known as Amy Lyn Avenue.

PART 2: That the City Engineer be, and is hereby authorized and directed to change his maps, plats and records to indicate such name to be the proper name of the street in question.

PART 3: That the City Planning Department be, and is hereby authorized and directed to change its maps, plats and records to reflect such name change, and further that the City Planning Department shall provide notice of the naming of such street to all other City departments, including the Fire and Police Departments.

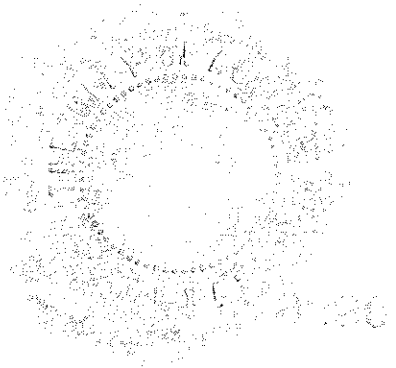
