AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, CHANGING THE NAME OF NELSON AVENUE TO TRANSFORMER TRAIL.

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Abilene that Nelson Avenue, in the City of Abilene, which is north of U.S. Highway 36, should be renamed Transformer Trail; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that Nelson Avenue should be renamed Transformer Trail; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Nelson Avenue, which is north of U.S. Highway 36, be renamed and will hereafter be known as Transformer Trail.

PART 2: That the City Engineer be and is hereby authorized and directed to change his maps, plats and records to include such name to be the proper name of the street described above.

PART 3: The the Planning and Community Development Department be, and is hereby authorized and directed to change its maps, plats and records to reflect such name change, and further that the Planning and Community Development Department shall provide notice of the re-naming of such street to all other City departments including the Fire and Police Departments.

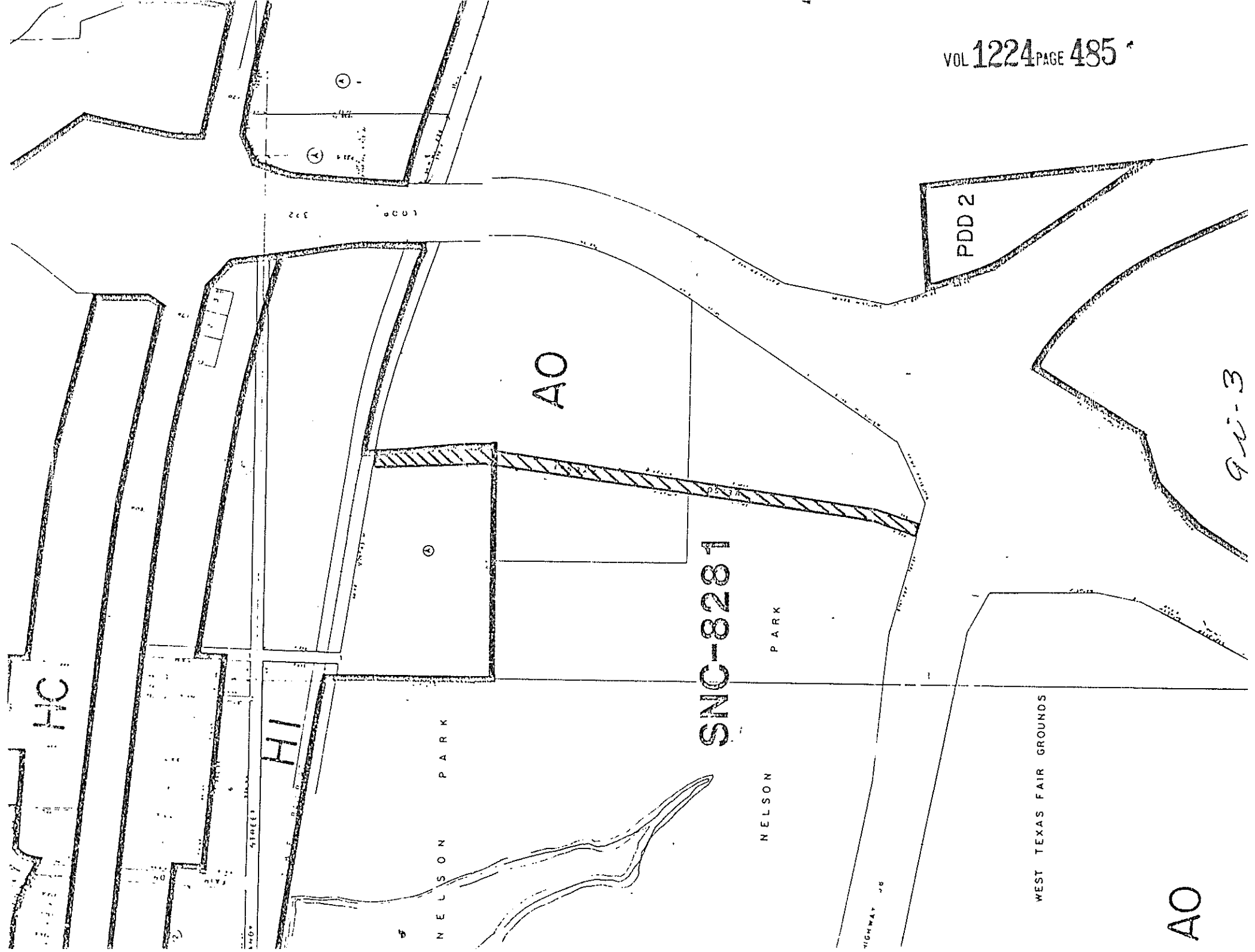
