

ORDINANCE NO. 13-1981

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING REVENUE SHARING BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OCTOBER 1, 1980, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 1981, FOR THE CITY OF ABILENE; APPROPRIATING FUNDS; AND HOLDING A PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, the City Manager, on August 13, 1980, filed a proposed budget with the City Secretary for the regular city budget fiscal year commencing October 1, 1980; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council reviewed, considered, and adopted said budget; and,

WHEREAS, said budget did not include revenue sharing items because federal funds had not been approved for revenue sharing; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the Revenue Sharing Budget for the fiscal year October 1, 1980, through September 30, 1981, for the City of Abilene, be, and the same is hereby approved and adopted.

PART 2: That the several amounts, as set forth in the proposed Revenue Sharing Budget be, and are hereby appropriated to the objects and purpose therein named.

PART 3: That a copy of the 1980-1981 budget shall be filed with the City Secretary, the County Clerk of Taylor County, the County Clerk of Jones County, and the State Comptroller at Austin, as required by State law.

PART 4: That the City Council hereby finds that an emergency exists requiring suspension of the Rule provided in Section 18 of the City Charter requiring Ordinances to be read on two (2) separate days, in that the immediate passage of said ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public welfare; to-wit; that delaying the passage of this ordinance will possibly cause some projects to not be able to be completed because inflation is causing the cost for many budgeted items to rise; therefore, said Rule 18 is hereby suspended and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
