ORDINANCE NO. 30-1983

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ABANDONMENT OF A PORTION OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY; PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SUCH ABANDONMENT, AND CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the following described portion of a Public Right of Way, as described on Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance for all purposes, be, and the same is hereby abandoned, vacated and closed insofar as the right, title or easement of the public is concerned.

PART 2: That said portion of a Public Right of Way is not needed for public purposes and it is in the public interest of the City of Abilene to abandon said described portion of a Public Right of Way.

PART 3: That the abandonment provided for herein shall extend only to the public right, title and easement in and to the tracts of land described in Part 1 of this ordinance, and shall be construed only to that interest the governing body of the City of Abilene may legally and lawfully abandon.

PASSED ON FIRST READING this the 24 day of March, A.D. 19 83.

A notice of the time and place, where and when said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage, was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper, of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the 6 day of March, 19 83, the same being more than twenty-four (24) hours prior to the time designated for said hearing. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said ordinance was passed on second and final reading.

EXHIBIT "A"

Legal Description:

Being a 20 foot x 184.7 foot alley between Lots 1 & 2 and 3 & 4, Block 3 and a 20 foot x 393.4 foot alley between Lots 1-4 and 5-9, Block 2, Ronald Subdivision, Abilene Taylor County, Texas

and

The west 550 feet of Potomac Street beginning at the east property line of Vapor Trail and extending east for a distance of 550 feet.

SAVE AND EXCEPT for that portion of a north-south utility easement going across the three requested abandonments in the following locations: a 20' x 10' easement a distance of 184.7 feet from the east property line of Vapor Trail in Block 3, Ronald Subdivision and a 20' x 60' easement a distance of 184.7 feet from the east property line of Vapor Trail located in Potomac Street and a 20' x 20' easement a distance of 184.7 feet from the east property line of Vapor Trail in Block 2, Ronald Subdivision.
