

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ABANDONMENT OF A PORTION OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY; PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SUCH ABANDONMENT, AND CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the following described portion of a Public Right of Way, as described on Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance for all purposes, be, and the same is hereby abandoned, vacated and closed insofar as the right, title or easement of the public is concerned.

PART 2: That said portion of a Public Right of Way is not needed for public purposes and it is in the public interest of the City of Abilene to abandon said described portion of a Public Right of Way.

PART 3: That the abandonment provided for herein shall extend only to the public right, title and easement in and to the tracts of land described in Part 1 of this ordinance, and shall be construed only to that interest the governing body of the City of Abilene may legally and lawfully abandon.

PASSED ON FIRST READING this the 10 day of July,

A notice of the time and place, where and when said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage, was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper, of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the 6 day of July,
19 86, the same being more than twenty-four (24) hours prior to the time designated for said hearing. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said ordinance was passed on second and final reading.

EXHIBIT "A"

Thoroughfare abandonment, being: (1) 10' adjacent to the north and south right-of-way lines of North 14th Street from the west right-of-way line of N. Treadaway to the east right-of-way line of Ash St. and from the west right-of-way line of Ash St. to the east right-of-way line of Plum St.; (2) 10' adjacent to the east and west right-of-way lines of Ash Street from the south right-of-way line of North 16th Street to the north right-of-way line of N. 14th St. and from the south right-of-way line of N. 14th St. to the north right-of-way line of N. 13th St., Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, save and except retention of a sidewalk easement over any sidewalks, and one foot on either side of said sidewalks,

taken out of the rights-of-way because of the abandonment; all within the L.C. Morrow Subdivision out of Block 199, Original Town, Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, filed for record April 28, 1908, and found in Vol. 1, Page 59 of the Taylor County Clerk's Plat Records; and the College Drive Addition, Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, filed for record March 30, 1929, and found in Vol. 1, Page 591 of the Taylor County Clerk's Plat Records.
