

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, CHANGING THE NAME OF E.S. 15th STREET, S. 15th STREET/BERRY LANE TO SOUTH 14th STREET.

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Abilene that E.S. 15th St., S. 15th St./Berry Ln., in the City of Abilene, which is located between Maple Street and South Treadaway Boulevard

should be renamed; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that this street should be renamed; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That E.S. 15th St., S. 15th St./Berry Ln. as described above, be renamed and will hereafter be known as South 14th Street.

PART 2: That the City Engineer be and is hereby authorized and directed to change his maps, plats and records to include such name to be the proper name of the street described above.

PART 3: That the Planning Department, be and is hereby authorized and directed to change its maps and records to reflect such name change, and further that the Planning Department shall provide notice of the renaming of such street to all other City departments including the Fire and Police Departments.

PART 4: A notice of the time and place, where and when said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage, was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the 3 day of January, 1988, the same being more than twenty-four (24) hours prior to a public hearing to be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall in Abilene, Texas, at 9:00 a.m., on the 28 day of January, 1988, to permit the public to be heard prior to final consideration of this ordinance.

PASSED ON SECOND AND FINAL READING this 28 day of January, A.D. 1988.
