

ORDINANCE NO. 1-1990

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 34-1989, PART 5, CLASSIFIED POSITIONS FOR POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Part 5 of Ordinance No. 34-1989 is hereby amended to read as follows:

That the number, classification and designation of each position, as provided in V.T.C.A., Local Government Code Chapter 143 Municipal Civil Service, for the Police and Fire Department, as set out below, are hereby created, established and adopted as the official plan for the classified service of the Police and Fire Departments of the City of Abilene for the remainder of the fiscal year October 1, 1989, through September 30, 1990. The Fire Department Captain who is assigned the duties of Fire Marshal may receive Assignment Pay in an amount necessary to make the Fire Marshal's base pay equivalent to District Chief base pay. Any position in the classified service of the Police and Fire Departments of the City of Abilene not below listed, is hereby abolished:

PART 2: That Article II Fire Marshal, Sections 10-17, 10-19, and 10-34 of the Abilene Municipal Code, be repealed.

PART 3: That said Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its second and final reading.
