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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 23, "PLANNING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT," SUBPART E, "ZONING," OF THE ABILENE MUNICIPAL CODE, BY CHANGING THE ZONING DISTRICT BOUNDARIES AFFECTING CERTAIN PROPERTIES, AS DESCRIBED BELOW, DECLARING A PENALTY, AND CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Chapter 23, Subpart E, known as the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Abilene, is hereby amended by changing the zoning district boundaries as set out in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance for all purposes.

PART 2: That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00). Each day such violation shall continue or be permitted to continue, shall be deemed a separate offense.

EXHIBIT "A"

Rezone property from AO (Agricultural Open Space) to GC (General Commercial) zoning district.

Legal Description:

Being 6.57 acres of land out of a 10 acre tract of land out of John Adams Survey No. 44, Taylor County, Texas and said 10 acre tract being of record in Volume 1488, Page 863, Deed Records, Taylor County, Texas and said 6.57 acre tract being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a 1/2 metal rebar found on the North right of way of FM Highway 3438 (right of way varies and North line of said right of way recorded in Volume 1354, Page 569, said Deed Records) for the South corner of this tract same being the Southwest corner of a 2.00 acre tract of land recorded in Volume 1926, Page 717, Official Public Records, Taylor County, Texas, whence a bronze disc found in concrete bears S51°26'43"E 19.35';

Thence N51°26'43"W with the North line of said highway 237.39' to a 1/2" metal rebar set for the West corner of this tract whence a 3/8" metal rebar found on the West line of said 15 acre tract bears N51°26'43"W 44.13' and a bronze disc found in concrete bears N51°26'43"W 250.48';
