

ORDINANCE NO. 19-2000

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, NAMING AN UNNAMED STREET TO **PET HAVEN ROAD**.

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Abilene that an unnamed street in the City of Abilene, which is east-west street located east from Elmdale Road to the City limits, should be named; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that this street should be named; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That an unnamed east-west street located east from Elmdale Road to the City limits, as described above, be named and will hereafter be known as Pet Haven Road.

PART 2: That the City Engineer be and is hereby authorized and directed to change his maps, plats, and records to include such name to be the proper name of the street described above.

PART 3: That the Planning Department, be and is hereby authorized and directed to change its maps, plats, and records to reflect such name, and further that the Planning Department shall provide notice of the naming of such street to all other City departments including the Fire and Police Departments.

PART 4: A notice of the time and place, where and when said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage, was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the 30 day of April, 2000, the same being more than twenty-four (24) hours prior to a public hearing to be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall in Abilene, Texas, at 9:00 a.m., on the 25 day of May, 2000, to permit the public to be heard prior to final consideration of this ordinance.
