

ORDINANCE NO. 37-2019

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 20-2018, ADOPTING A NEW FEE FOR SOLID WASTE FOR COMMERCIAL USERS BRUSH DISPOSAL, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES, RESOLUTIONS AND PARTS OF RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, City Council adopted Ordinance 54-2018 ("Fee Ordinance") on September 13, 2018 setting fees and charges commencing on October 1, 2018; and

WHEREAS, It was contemplated that this Fee Ordinance would require amendment from time to time to modify and update fees and charges; and

WHEREAS, the Fee Ordinance included the Solid Waste Fee Schedule for the City of Abilene, Texas; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to establish a new fee for commercial users at the City Brush Center; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Part 1: That the Schedule of Fees and Charges for the Solid Waste Fee Schedule for the City of Abilene, Texas, be amended as set forth in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made part of this Ordinance for all purposes.

Part 2: That all ordinances, parts of ordinances, resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are repealed.

Part 3: That if any provision or any section of this ordinance shall be held to be void or unconstitutional, such holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

PASSED ON FIRST READING June 27, 2019

A notice of time and place, where and when said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of

general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the 7th day of July, 2019, the same being more than 24 hours prior to a public hearing being held in the Council Chamber of City Hall in Abilene, Texas, at 8:30 a.m. on the 11th of July, 2019, to permit the public to be heard.
