

ORDINANCE NO. 25-2020

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AMENDING THE "LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE" OF THE ABILENE CITY CODE, CONCERNING PDD 166, A PLANNED DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT; CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING; PROVIDING A PENALTY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the Land Development Code of the City of Abilene, is hereby amended by changing the zoning district boundaries as set out in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance for all purposes.

PART 2: That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00). Each day such violation shall continue or be permitted to continue, shall be deemed a separate offense.


PASSED ON FIRST READING the 25th day of June, 2020.

A notice of the time and place, where and when said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage, was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the 23rd day of May, 2020, the same being more than fifteen (15) days prior to a public hearing to be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall in Abilene, Texas, at 8:30 a.m., on the 9th day of July, 2020, to permit the public to be heard prior to final consideration of this ordinance. Said ordinance, being a penal ordinance, becomes effective ten (10) days after its publication in the newspaper, as provided by Section 19 of the Charter of the City of Abilene.

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Exhibit "A"

PART 1: Land Title. Title to land not dedicated to public use and services or for utility purposes and not otherwise designated for development purposes shall remain in possession of the owner thereof, his heirs, assigns, lessees and successors in interest and shall not be the responsibility of the City of Abilene for any purpose.

PART 2: Development Specifications. All development in the Planned Development shall be in accordance with any maps, topographical and drainage plans, utility plans, architectural drawings, site plan, plat, and any other required plans filed in connection with this requested Planned Development, which are hereby incorporated by reference and included as part of this ordinance. All use and development within the Planned Development must be in compliance with the general Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City of Abilene except as otherwise specifically provided herein.

PART 3: Building Specifications. All structures in the herein said Planned Development shall be constructed in accordance with all pertinent building and construction codes of the City of Abilene.

PART 4: Zoning. That the Land Development Code of the City of Abilene is hereby further amended by changing the zoning district boundaries, as hereinafter set forth: from Multi-family (MF) and Light Industrial (LI) to PD (Planned Development) District.

That the Planning Director be, and is hereby authorized and directed to change the official Zoning Map of the City of Abilene to correctly reflect the amendments thereto.

PART 5: Legal Description. The legal description of this PD is as follows:

Lots 7-12 in Block 66, Lots 1-6,7,8 and 12 in Block 67 as well as Lot 7 and the south 11-feet of Lot 8 in Block 104, in Original Town of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas.



Location:

630 N. 5th Street, 629 N 6th Street and approximately 2.1 acres of vacant land within the Original Town of Abilene

PART 6: Purpose. The purpose of the Planned Development (PD) request is to allow all uses classified as manufacturing (light) within Section 5.1.1.3 "Land Use Definitions" found in Abilene's Land Development Code, as well as all other uses allowed (by right or, if ordinarily necessary, with approval of a Conditional Use Permit) in Central Business zoning districts.

PART 7: Specific Modifications. This Planned Development shall be subject to the requirements of the Central Business (CB) zoning district, except as modified below:

- a. Uses classified as manufacturing (light) as defined in Section 5.1.1.3 in Abilene's Land Development Code are permitted.
- b. All uses ordinarily requiring a Conditional Use Permit in Central Business are permitted by right.

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
