### **ORDINANCE NO. 35-2020**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 18, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," ARTICLE VIII, "SCHEDULES," SECTION 18-299, "PARKING TIME LIMITED," AND SECTION 18-300, "PARKING METER ZONES" AS SET OUT BELOW; AND CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, the Mayor's Downtown Task Force, has made various recommendations regarding the improvements of available on-street parking, metered zoned parking and limits on timed parking within the downtown area; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene is currently in the process of improving the efficiency of downtown parking; and,

WHEREAS, improvements include removing the metered street parking and adjusting time limits on certain streets within the downtown; and,

# NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

- PART 1: That Chapter 18, "Motor Vehicles and Traffic," Article VIII, "Schedules," Section 18-299, "Parking time limited," of the Abilene City Code be amended as set out in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance for all purposes.
- PART 2: That Chapter 18, "Motor Vehicles and Traffic," Article VIII, "Schedules," Section 18-300, "Parking meter zones," be amended as set out in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made part of this Ordinance for all purposes.
- PART 3: That if the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision or clause of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not effect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance.
- **PART 4:** That any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed to have committed a misdemeanor, and

upon conviction thereof shall be fined in accordance with Chapter 1 (Section 1-9) of this Code.

PART 5: Each day such violation shall continue, or be permitted to continue, shall be deemed a separate offense. Said ordinance, being a penal ordinance, becomes effective ten (10) days after its publication in the newspaper, as provided by Section 19 of the Charter of the City of Abilene.

## PASSED ON FIRST READING this 24th day of September, 2020.

A notice of the time and place, where and when said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on 27<sup>th</sup> day of September 2020, the same being more than 24 hours prior to a public hearing being held in the Council Chamber of City Hall in Abilene, Texas, at 8:30 a.m. on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2020, to permit the public to be heard.

### Exhibit A

## Sec. 18-299. Parking time limited.

In accordance with the terms of this chapter, and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall stand, stop or park a vehicle in excess of the indicated period of time specified in this schedule on the indicated days on the indicated sides of the following streets or portions of streets. Each consecutive increment of the time limit during which a vehicle remains continuously parked shall be deemed to be a separate offense.
