

**ORDINANCE NO. 65-2021**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 18, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," ARTICLE XIII, "SCHEDULES," SECTION 18-297, "STOPPING, STANDING, PARKING," OF THE ABILENE MUNICIPAL CODE, BY AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS AS SET OUT BELOW; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING A PENALTY**

**WHEREAS**, in order to improve traffic safety on East North 10<sup>th</sup> Street, there is a need to establish a designated no-parking area near its intersection with Griffith Road.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**

**PART 1:** That Chapter 18, "Motor Vehicles and Traffic," Article XIII, "Schedules," Section 18-297, "Stopping, standing and parking prohibited," of the Abilene City Code be amended as set out in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance for all purposes.

**PART 2:** That if the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision or clause of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not effect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance.

**PART 3:** That any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed to have committed a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in accordance with Chapter 1 (Section 1-9) of this Code.

**PART 4:** Each day such violation shall continue, or be permitted to continue, shall be deemed a separate offense. Said ordinance, being a penal ordinance, becomes effective ten (10) days after its publication in the newspaper, as provided by Section 19 of the Charter of the City of Abilene.


**PASSED ON FIRST READING this 4<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2021.**



**Exhibit A**

**Sec. 18-297. Stopping, standing and parking prohibited.**

In accordance with the terms of this chapter, and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall stand, stop or park a vehicle during the times specified in this schedule on the indicated sides of the following streets or portions of streets:

(a) At all times (Sundays and legal holidays included):

<i>(add)</i>	<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Extent</u>
	<u>East North 10<sup>th</sup> Street</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>From 965 feet east of Griffith Rd. to 1575 feet east of Griffith Rd.</u>
	<u>East North 10<sup>th</sup> Street</u>	<u>South</u>	<u>From 1400 feet east of Griffith Rd. to 1575 feet east of Griffith Rd.</u>
